## **CHAPTER V**

## CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

## A. Conclusion

After analyzing the data, the conclusions can be reached as follows:

- 1. There are 4 types of slang word found in Wednesday 2022 series, 6 out of 8 chapter there are coinage slang, blending slang, acronym slang and clipping slang
- 2. The number of slang words found in the Wednesday 2022 movie series, the researcher found that the most common type of slang is coinage slang.
- 3. The number of slang words found in the Wednesday 2022 movie series, the researcher found that the least type of slang is acronym slang and clipping slang.

Based on the above results, the researcher wondering that learning and understanding the meaning of slang in movies can help EFL learners improve their English language skills. but it should be done with some considerations:
