Due to pandemic Covid-19 all the teaching learning activity was stopped, including activities at the university level. One of the affected course is microteaching, previously microteaching done by offline should shifted into online mode. Microteaching is one of the compulsory subject for education students to practice their teaching ability. This research aims to analyze English students' experiences and find out the challenges on teaching practice in online microteaching subject. Experiences is something that related with persons' memories. Type of this research is descriptive qualitative. The research was carried out with 31 pre-service English teachers at Nahdlatul Ulama Sunan Giri University in eight semesters. An interview guideline with 10 questions was employed in order to determine students' experiences. The second instrument was a closed questionnaire consisted of 28 statements by online. The result showed that most respondents interviewed admitted that teaching practice in online microteaching difficult, less effective and many challenges. The questionnaire finding was support there are 9,7% survey respondents were strongly agreed, 35,5% were agreed and 35,5% neutral that teaching practice in online microteaching not comfort. It means that pre-service English teachers dominant have negative experiences during teaching practice in online microteaching class.

Akibat pandemi Covid-19 semua kegiatan pembelajaran dihentikan, termasuk kegiatan di tingkat universitas. Salah satu mata kuliah yang terdampak adalah mikro teaching, sebelumnya microteaching yang dilakukan secara offline harus berubah menjadi mode onlen. Mikro teaching adalah salah satu mata kuliah mahasiswa pendidikan untuk mempraktikkan kemampuan mengajarnya. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menganalisis pengalaman mahasiswa Bahasa Inggris dan mengetahui tantangan pada saat praktik mengajar pada mata kuliah mikro teaching secara onlen. Pengalaman adalah sebuah hal yang berhubungan dengan ingatan seseorang. Penelitian ini dilakukan dengan 31 calon guru Bahasa Inggris di Universitas Nahdlatul Ulama Sunan Giri di semester 8. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa sebagian besar mahasiswa yang diwawancarai mengakui bahwa praktik mengajar dalam microteaching onlen itu sulit, kurang efektif dan banyak tantangan. Hasil angket menunjukkan 9,7% mahasiswa menjawab sangat setuju, 35,5% menjawab setuju dan 35,5% merespon netral bahwa praktik mengajar di microteaching onlen tidak nyaman. Artinya para calon guru Bahasa Inggris memiliki pengalaman negatif selama praktik mengajar di kelas mikroteaching onlen.
