

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter presents the conclusion and suggestions of the study conducted by the researcher about fostering students' ability in writing narrative text using Comic strips at the eighth grade.

5.1 Conclusion

One of the language elements that must be taught to either Junior High School or Senior High School students was writing. In teaching writing it did not stand alone but it should be integrated into one of the language skills. Comic strip was a medium that was suitable to be used in teaching English, especially in teaching writing.

Based on the research result and discussion, Comic strips could help students improve their writing skills, especially when creating narrative texts for eighth-grade students. It was represented by the increase of the score and mean score between the pre-test and post-test. It could be the reason that using Comic strip was effective to teach students how to write narrative texts would improve their writing skills. Besides, the data analysis revealed that the t-test value indicated a significant difference. The T-test value is 0.000 which means its lower than Alfa (0.05). Because of this, H₀ was rejected and H_a was accepted. So, the use of Comic strips were effective to improve students' ability in writing narrative text.

5.2 Suggestion

Based on the conclusion, there were several suggestions related to the learning process using Comic strips, including:

1. The Teacher

The teacher should be creative in conducting the teaching and learning process. There are many media or techniques which can be used in teaching English, especially in writing skills. Sometimes teachers are only concerned toward students writing products and ignore the process. The teacher can use the comic strip as media in teaching writing, especially in teaching narrative text. So, it can


develop learning models that are effective, efficient, and able to make students enjoy and active writing narrative text, thus students can improve their writing skills.

2. The students

Writing skill is important for students both in their native language and also in English. By writing they can express and share their ideas through writing.
