## ABSTRACT

The rise of English-based applications among young Indonesians, especially students, has created a unique experience in learning English. One of the most popular apps is OME TV. Ome TV is a random video call application that connects users from various countries, including Indonesia. This phenomenon made the researcher conduct this research. This study aims to determine students' perceptions and experiences in practicing English using Ome TV and to find out the challenges and obstacles in the process of practicing English. This research uses descriptive qualitative method. In collecting data using several research instruments, namely questionnaires, interviews and observations of the Ome TV application. In this study, the results showed that 61% said that learning to use Ome TV was fun and enjoyable, 39% stated that they strongly agreed that Ome TV provides users who communicate using English as the main language so that it supports students to practice English skills. On the contrary, 61% stated agree with the challenges associated with user accents on Ome TV. besides that, 46.3% agreed that there were obstacles related to the unstable network signal when accessing Ome TV. On the other hand, 41.5% also agreed with the inappropriate actions that were received from some persons who used Ome TV. So it can be concluded that students gave a positive response to the use of Ome TV as a medium for practicing English, but with several obstacles encountered from the internet network and devices that did not support it, and there were challenges from differences in accent. and vocabulary that students have never encountered.

Maraknya aplikasi berbasis bahasa Inggris di kalangan anak muda Indonesia, khususnya mahasiswa, menciptakan pengalaman tersendiri dalam belajar bahasa Inggris. Salah satu aplikasi yang paling populer adalah OME TV. Ome TV adalah aplikasi video call acak yang menghubungkan pengguna dari berbagai negara, termasuk Indonesia. Fenomena tersebut membuat peneliti melakukan penelitian ini. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui persepsi dan pengalaman mahasiswa dalam berlatih bahasa Inggris menggunakan Ome TV dan untuk mengetahui tantangan dan hambatan dalam proses berlatih bahasa Inggris. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode kualitatif deskriptif. Dalam pengumpulan data menggunakan beberapa instrumen penelitian yaitu kuesioner, wawancara dan observasi terhadap aplikasi Ome TV. Dalam penelitian ini didapatkan hasil 61% mengatakan bahwa belajar menggunakan Ome TV asyik dan menyenangkan, 39% menyatakan sangat setuju bahwa Ome TV menyediakan pengguna yang berkomunikasi menggunakan bahasa Inggris sebagai bahasa utama sehingga mendukung mahasiswa untuk mempraktekkan kemampuan bahasa Inggris, dibalik hal tersebut 61% menyatakan setuju dengan adanya tantangan berkaitan dengan aksentuasi pengguna di Ome TV. selain itu juga 46.3% menyatakan setuju dengan adanya hambatan berkenaan dengan jaringan sinyal yang kurang stabil saat mengakses Ome TV. lain halnya 41,5% juga menyatakan setuju dengan adanya tindakan kurang pantas yang didapat dari beberapa oknum yang menggunakan Ome TV. Sehingga dapat disimpulkan bahwa siswa memberikan respon positif terhadap penggunaan Ome TV sebagai media untuk berlatih bahasa Inggris, namun dengan beberapa kendala yang ditemui dari jaringan internet dan perangkat yang tidak mendukung, serta terdapat tantangan dari perbedaan logat. dan kosa kata yang belum pernah ditemui mahasiswa.

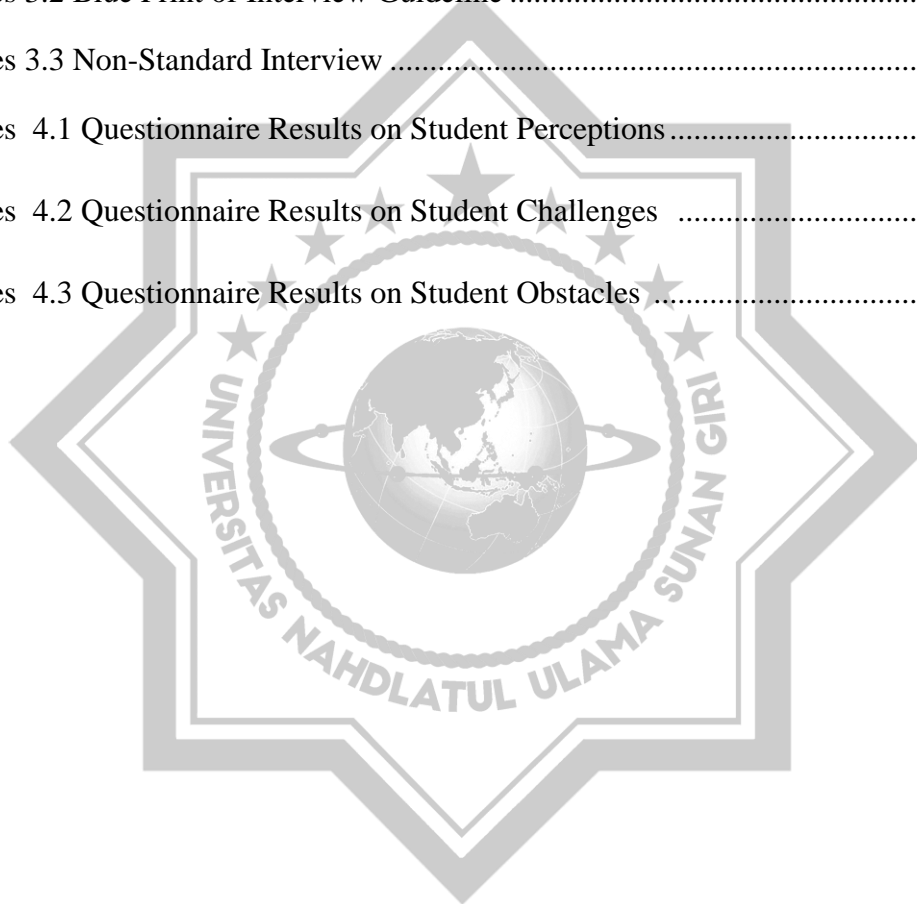
Figure 2.1 Ome TV in Apps Store .....	25

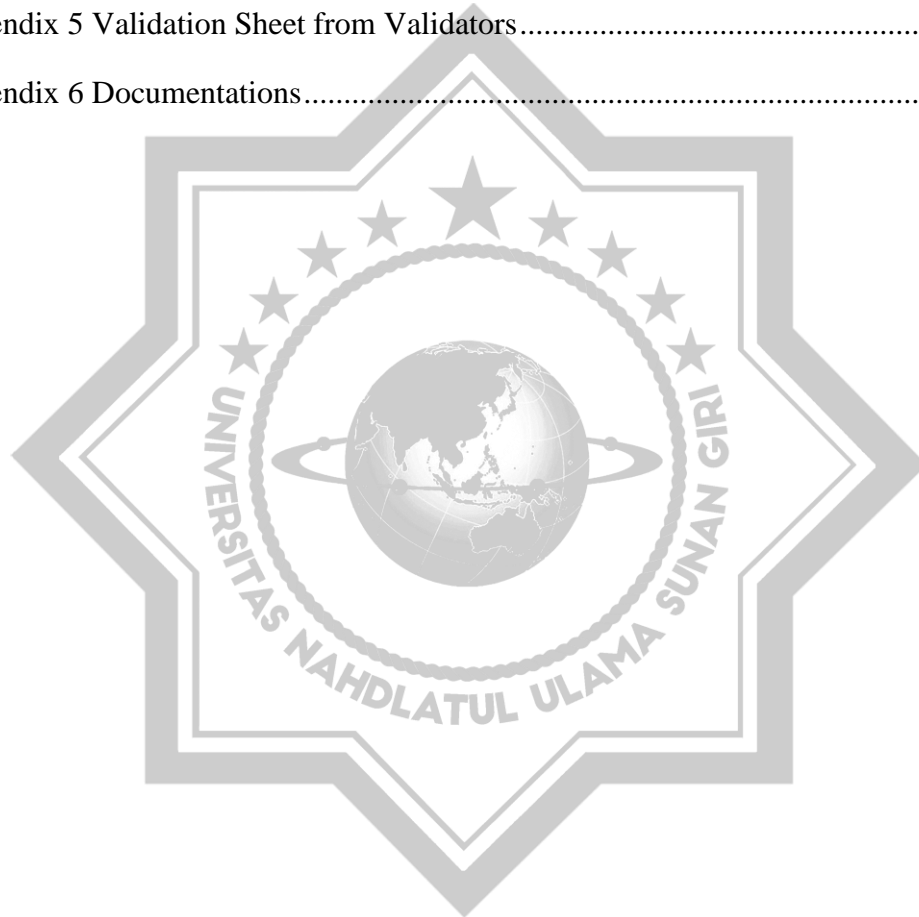
