

CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Study

According to Rabiah (2020:3-4) quote from Chaer and Agustina (2004:26-29) language refers to the tool of communication that is expressed through the arrangement of sounds or written expressions that are structured to form larger units, such as morphemes, words, and sentences. Meanwhile, in the perspective of Functional Systemic Linguistics (LSF), language is a form of social semiotics that is working in a situational context and cultural context, which is used both orally

and in writing. In the LSF perspective, language is seen as a construction that is formed through simultaneous functions and systems.

According to Sariyanti Daok (2015:2), Recount texts are one of the texts that are most relevant to the student's life because they are texts that recount past events where the setting and events occur naturally based on the sequence of time, as opposed to narrative texts where the climax and the resolution of the problem must be created in the story. Students can therefore use recall texts to study intriguing or memorable events they have already had or persons in their immediate environment. In fact, the majority of them consider writing to be a hassle since they have trouble adhering to grammar rules, which frequently results in errors in the written work.

Based on the experience above, the researcher interest to conduct this research to analyze their writing errors and find the source of the errors that lead to errors in writing recount text because writing is important especially academic writing.

1.2 Scope and Limitation of the Problem
